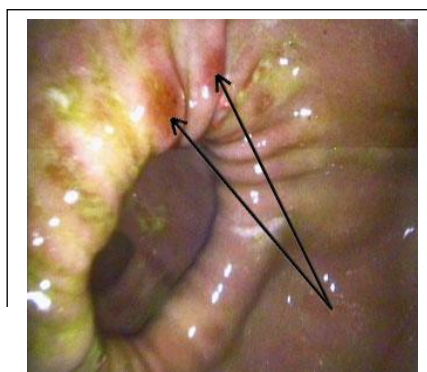

The usual cost of this procedure plus sedation would be £175.
